**Colusa Police Department
Monthly Report**

June 2010

Note: Lieutenant Stark reporting in for Chief Montgomery, who as of this writing, was off work on sick leave.

Activities

- Officers provided traffic control for the annual County Fair Parade sponsored by the Lions Club. All went well. Of special note was the assistance given by Public Works, Fire Department and the Senior Volunteers.
- Officers were provided to assist CHP with patrols at the County Fair, with officers provided three of the four nights. No significant police activity was encountered.
- Officers attended training for back injury reduction. The training went well.

Statistics

- There were 466 calls for service, down from the 514 in May.
- There were 63 documented case investigations, with 44 cases concerning criminal activity. Two traffic collisions were reported in the month.
- Sixteen in-custody arrests (people went to jail) were made during the month, including three DUI, two drug arrests and one Domestic Violence arrest.
- There were 138 traffic citations issued in the month, with 83 being moving violations, 10 driver license violations (either unlicensed or suspended license violations) and 45 mechanical violations. The lead moving violations were speeding, stop sign and cell phone use.
