STREETS/PARKS DIVISION

Parks: Routine parks & pool maintenance, banners, play equipment inspection and repairs, graffiti and weed removal, and tree trimming. Routine preparations in Ball Park. Repair park irrigation. WATER/SEWER DIVISION

Meetings: Weekly Tailgate Safety meetings, Insurance Meeting and “Back Safe” training.
Routine: Service Requests & Work Orders, O&M of water and wastewater systems and USA's.
Water: Repaired two (2) service lines and three (3) bell joints in water mains, replaced twenty five (25) meter registers, fifteen (15) MXU's and installed a new water service. Install new water line on 14th St. (900 ft) to tie into four (4) services and abandon old R/R line from Cooper's Extension (CSA #3). Work with Hospital on irrigation water. Proceed with underground for the bathroom at Will S. Green Park. Helped get pool filter running.
Sewer: Cleaned 8000 feet of sewer main and cleaned out lift stations. Unplug three (3) sewer mains. Finish building ramps in Pond 6 for Solar Array. Started pumping down solids storage pond # 1 to # 2.
