4. **REPORT ON RECREATION PROGRAMS**

Recreation Supervisor Cabral gave the following report:

Better Body Fitness – This is a new program that will be offered on Mon.-Wed.-Fri. in the City Hall Auditorium from 8:30-9:45 am and 4-5:15 pm beginning September 14th.

Senior Fitness – This is a new program that will be offered on Mon. & Wed. from 10-10:30am in the City Hall Auditorium beginning September 14th.

Ballroom Dancing – This program will be offered in the City Hall Auditorium on Thursday evenings From 7-9 pm beginning September 24th.

Co-Ed Volleyball – This is a new program that will be held on Monday evenings at Egling Middle School gym from 7-9 pm beginning October 9th.

Sr. Walk – This program is held every Tuesday at 9am with 6-8 seniors participating each week.

Sr. Game Day – This program is held every Wednesday at 1pm in the Sr. Room at City Hall, there are 8-10 participants each week.

Adult Canteen – This program is held the 1st and last Friday of each month at the Methodist Church Hall. There are @ 40-45 seniors who attend each time.

Co-Ed Slow Pitch has concluded for the year. There were 7 teams that participated.

For people to donate to help offset cost of bands. For the entire summer there was \$604 collected. Pool closed for the summer on August 12th. The new programs of Water Aerobics and Teen Night Were very successful.

5. REPORTS ON BOAT LAUNCH AND PARK BOND PROJECTS

Administrator Hickel reported that her last communication with the Deputy Director of Boats and Waterways on the status of the boat launch project was that they could not find the contracts so she

Was having staff go back and prepare the documents once again.

The City Council has set a committee of two council members to work with two board of supervisors as well as city staff to meet with State Park representatives to discuss potential closure, possible ways to keep park open, etc.

Adminstrator Hickel also reported that she is still awaiting word from State Parks and Recreation on the change of scope to the Colusa Athletic Facility project. There is @\$174,000 of park bond money remaining in the cities per capita money and applications are being accepted for projects at this time. Staff will be completing project applications for restrooms at Will S. Green Park, group picnic area at CD Semple as well as individual basketball courts at Will S. Green and CD Semple Parks. All of these projects are indentified in the Park and Recreation Master Plan. Once applications are completed they will go to city council for approval and then be sent off to State Parks and Recreation.
